

Welche Stadien nimmt ein Job ein?

Die einzelnen Phasen können Sie erkennen, wenn Sie einen Befehl mit entsprechenden Debug-Optionen ausführen.

Hier als Beispiel die Ausführung für einen `savefs` Befehl (`savefs -p -D5`):
